

A27 example tunnel /green bridge

The A27 at Southwick near Brighton 1992-194 was the first example of a Hindhead type tunnel in the UK. It's 390 metres long and like Hindhead has some involvement with the National Trust. It also isn't that far below ground around 10 metres, 20 metres to the base, yet still justifiable vs. 25-30metres for the A417.
